In business for over 30 years, Mardina started as a partnership between brothers Bill and Casey Klaassen in 1977 and is currently owned by Casey and his wife Diane.

Initially focused on residential construction, (with crews split between framing and concrete work) we have evolved to take on larger and more complex projects. In 1993, Mardina Construction was hired as the forming contractor for the Justice Institute of B.C. This building was a defining project for the us and proved we were capable of executing multi-million dollar contracts.

With our main focus on high end architectural concrete, we have not forgotten our roots, from a buried culvert to a soaring community centre, our commitment to quality and pride in our workmanship remains the same.

We have completed over 100 projects throughout the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley and coastal regions of British Columbia. With projects ranging from major public recreational centres including pools, theatres and schools to industrial use buildings including freezers, warehouses and offices, we bring a wide assortment of skills and experience to any concrete job. Our hard earned reputation for getting the job done right, with a proactive attitude to addressing and resolving problems before they become issues, allows us to work closely with designers, contractors and clients alike to make the building process more efficient and effective, saving both money and time, and ensuring that our finished product meets your highest standards.

Offering both an efficient construction process and with continually improving architectural design options, tilt-up construction continues to evolve and become a more common and desirable form of construction. Once tilted, a concrete panel provides both building support and a secure exterior skin, and is one of the most cost effective construction methods in use today.

In 1999 we constructed our first tilt-up school. Since then we have been involved with many more tilt-ups from simple boxes to complex masterpieces, and arguably three of the most notable tilt-up projects in British Columbia.

The Gleneagles project in West Vancouver features 50' high curved panels that incorporate sandwich wall construction, in-wall radiant piping and finished concrete exposed on both sides. This project scored the highest score from the Tilt-up Concrete Association in 2004, and has won multiple awards since completion. Sunset Community Centre in Vancouver took the expectation of what can be achieved with tilt-up concrete to another level. Again incorporating insulated sandwich wall construction, this project is a testament to just how much can be done with tilt-up concrete construction, including the widest spandrel panel (80 plus feet) at the time. The Chilliwack Cultural Centre, currently under construction incorporates the tallest tilt-up panels in Canada. At 83' tall, 28 of these giants are being utilized to create the fly tower and elevator for the stage and theatre area.
