This building was a defining project for the us and proved we were capable of executing multi-million dollar contracts.

With our main focus on high end architectural concrete, we have not forgotten our roots, from a buried culvert to a soaring community centre, our commitment to quality and pride in our workmanship remains the same.

We have completed over 100 projects throughout the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley and coastal regions of British Columbia. With projects ranging from major public recreational centres including pools, theatres and schools to industrial use buildings including freezers, warehouses and offices, we bring a wide assortment of skills and experience to any concrete job. Offering an amazing range of design flexibility both aesthetically and structurally, cast-in-place concrete is used on nearly every building constructed in B.C. From foundations to roof slabs and all areas in between, it provides a key structural component that can be hidden by other finishes or left exposed taking advantage of the concrete for both the structural and architectural uses.

In 1993, Mardina Construction was hired as the cast-in-place forming contractor for the Justice Institute of B.C. This building was a defining project for the us and proved we were capable of constructing large scale architectural concrete projects.

With the completed Justice Institute under our respective tool belts, we constructed the first two of the Surrey Sister Schools concurrently, we have since gone on to build three more. Fraser Heights Sec, Clayton Sec, Ecole Kwantlen, Sullivan Heights Sec. & Panorama Ridge Sec. all incorporate extensive exposed concrete.

In 1999 we completed work on the Walnut Grove aquatic centre, which has led to numerous aquatic and recreational centre projects including SunGod in Delta, the West Van Aquatic Centre, Port Moody Rec. Centre, Chilliwack Aquatic Centre, and more recently both the Langley Events Centre and the 2010 Curling Venue, the Hillcrest Recreation Centre in Vancouver.

We have also constructed many other concrete buildings from 2-Storey single homes to 22-Storey Towers, Multi-level office buildings and base foundation work for steel or wood framed structures.

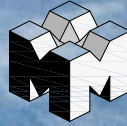
